REMINDER ... This Sunday, August 19, Masses will be at 8:00AM here at St. Patrick's and 10:00AM at St. Mary's to accommodate our car show.

MISSIONARY CO-OP PLAN ... This weekend, we take up the second special collection for the Missionary Co-op Plan. We also welcome Maryknoll Missioner, Fr. Doug May, who will speak at all the Masses. The Maryknoll Fathers and Brothers minister in 21 countries in Asia, Central and South America and Africa. Maryknolls' task is to share God's Word throughout the world, especially to the least of our brothers and sisters. Maryknollers share the Gospel through evangelization and through the actions of the Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy. Please use the Missionary Cooperation envelope that was in your packets for July 28/29. Thank you for your generosity.
