Notes from the Pastor's Desk

PLANNED GIVING: Capital Campaign ... So far we have received \$32140 in pledges from 17 parish families. Parishioners who were not able to attend one of our receptions will soon be receiving information about the campaign through the mail. We have also set up a display in the upstairs church lobby, which includes pamphlets with more details, for those wishing to read more about the campaign. We ask for your attention, consideration and prayers for the success of the campaign.

ATTENTION PFIZER EMPLOYEES ... We have just been informed that we cannot use the Pfizer Foundation Matching Gift Application for Seton Catholic School as part of this year's Capital Campaign. This applies to this year only. We apologize for any confusion this may cause.

HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION ... Thursday, November 1 (Feast of All Saints) is a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses will be at 9:00AM at St. Patrick's and 7:00PM at St. Mary's.

FIRST FRIDAY ... Friday, November 2, is First Friday at St. Patrick's. If you plan on taking an hour to adore the Blessed Sacrament, please sign up on the sheet provided at the entrance near the sanctuary. There should be at least two people present during the time of exposition. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will be immediately after the 9:00AM Mass and end at 11:00AM with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

ALL SOULS' DAY ENVELOPES ... All parishioners envelopes for the Feast of All Souls will be placed beside the Tabernacle both at St. Patrick's and St. Mary's. We pray for all those listed on these envelopes during the month of November. Any monetary offerings will be used for Masses for the souls in purgatory.
