CAPITAL CAMPAIGN ... It's Our Church ... It's Our Future ... As of January 4, St. Patrick's has raised \$120,018 from 80 donors. When we subtract the amount designated for our Bishop's Fund Appeal Goal and the 25% designated to the Diocesan Projects, so far, the income coming back to St. Patrick's, if all pledges are honored, is \$80,217 for our case statement of needs. If we look at the number of donors who have contributed versus donors from our Parish who are still prayerfully considering (80 donors from 545 families), our Parish is at about 15% participation rate. It is my hope that everyone will participate so that our very much needed parish projects will be able to get done. So if you have yet to make a donation or pledge we are really counting on all parishioners to make this happen. Thank you in advance for your generosity!
