CAPITAL CAMPAIGN ... It's Our Church ... It's Our Future ... As of February 1, St. Patrick's has raised \$120,618 from 82 donors. When we subtract the amount designated for our Bishop's Fund Appeal Goal and the 25% designated to the Diocesan Projects, so far, the income coming back to St. Patrick's, if all pledges are honored, is \$80,668 for our case statement of needs. If we look at the number of donors who have contributed versus donors from our Parish who are still prayerfully considering (82 donors from 545 families), our Parish is at about a 15% participation rate. It is our hope that everyone will consider participating. Thank you in advance for your generosity!
