Notes from the Pastor's Desk

JOURNEY THROUGH SCRIPTURE ... THE BIBLE AND THE SACRAMENTS ... The last session for this part of the program will be held this Thursday, April 11, from 6:30 to 8:00PM in the St. Patrick's Parish Center. The remaining 5 weeks will be in the fall.

THE LIGHT IS ON ... FOR YOU ... ALL DAY ... Make a good confession before Easter ... this Wednesday, April 10, at St. Peter's Church, Plattsburgh (sponsored by the parishes of the Clinton Deanery), starting at 7:30AM and continuing until 7:00PM.

CHANGES TO THE MASS SCHEDULE AT ST. PATRICK'S AND ST. MARY'S ... Starting on the weekend of April 28 (Divine Mercy Sunday), the Mass schedule will be as follows: St. Mary's will have an (Anticipated) 4:00PM Mass on Saturdays. There will not be a 4:00PM Mass at St. Patrick's or a 5:30PM Mass at St. Mary's. On Sundays, St. Patrick's will have two Masses, one at 8:00AM and the other at 10:00AM. There will not be an 8:00AM Mass at St. Mary's. While we know this may not be a popular decision for all parishioners, it is one that needs to be made. This will make it easier for visiting priests to help us on the weekends as well as for Noel and myself to avoid the travel back and forth to the two parishes, especially in the winter. We hope that our parishioners will be understanding of these changes and remain supportive of our parishes. We will continue to ensure that envelopes for each parish are returned each week for inclusion in our weekly collections. If you do not already have envelopes, please contact either Rectory to request them so that your donations are directed to your parish. As far as confessions are concerned, they will be from 3:00 - 3:45PM on Saturdays at St. Mary's and 7:15 - 7:45AM on Sundays at St. Patrick's.
