**CONGRATULATIONS TO BISHOP-ELECT DOUGLAS LUCIA ...** Pope Francis has appointed Fr. Douglas Lucia from the Diocese of Ogdensburg as the new Bishop for the Diocese of Syracuse. Bishop-Elect Lucia will become the 11<sup>th</sup> Bishop of Syracuse, succeeding Bishop Robert J. Cunningham. Bishop-elect Lucia grew up in Altona with his siblings. He will be ordained and installed at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Syracuse on August 8. Due to the capacity and related safety concerns, this event is by invitation only. However, there will be a Farewell Mass at St. Mary's Cathedral on Saturday, July 27 at 4:00PM with a reception to follow at the K of C Hall, 721 Hasbrouck St., Ogdensburg, NY. There will also be a Mass of Thanksgiving at the Church of the Holy Angels, Altona on September 1 at 10:00AM with a reception to follow at Holy Angels Hall, 523 Devils Den Road, Altona. Bishop-elect Lucia will be the shepherd of over 220,000 Catholics covering 5,479 square miles. We congratulate him and wish him well.
