Notes from the Pastor's Desk

PRIESTHOOD SUNDAY ... Please join us today on Priesthood Sunday in praying for our priests, praising God for their courage and their generosity. Let us show Fr. Lewis and Fr. Duc our encouragement and gratitude in thoughts and deeds. God bless our priests!

OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY ... October 7 is the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. We will mark the feast with a Rosary Rally on Sunday, October 6 at St. Patrick's. Following our 10:00AM Mass, we will have Eucharistic Adoration for an hour with Recitation of the Rosary, Benediction and Consecration of Family to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Additionally, we will hold a Rosary Congress following the 9:00AM Masses on October 7, 8 and 9, with Eucharistic Adoration and recitation of the Rosary. On October 10 and 11, we will have Eucharistic Adoration and recitation of the Rosary at 4:00PM at St. Mary's followed by Mass at 5:00PM. On October 12, there will be 9:00AM Mass at St. Mary's followed by Eucharistic Adoration and recitation of the Rosary. Lastly, the closing Mass will be on Sunday, October 13 at 10:00AM at St. Patrick's followed by Consecration of Family to the Immaculate Heart of Mary (with no Adoration or Rosary). We hope you will be able to join us.

FIRST FRIDAY ... Friday, October 4 is First Friday at St. Patrick's. If you plan on taking an hour to adore the Blessed Sacrament on this Friday, please take the time to sign up on the sheet provided at the entrance near the sanctuary. We need to ensure that at least two people are present during the time of exposition. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will be immediately after the 9:00AM Mass and end at 11:00AM with Benediction.

CHRISTIAN FORMATION

REGISTRATION ... will take place on Sunday, October 6 and 13. There is a **\$20 per family registration fee** that will help pay for your child's Activity and Workbooks. Classes will begin on Sunday, October 20, 8:45-9:45AM for Grades 1 to 8 in the Parish Center.

FIRST GRADE REGISTRATION ... If you have a child who will be beginning First Grade this coming school year, please fill out a registration card which can be found on the table in the upstairs front lobby of the church and drop it in the collection basket or at the Rectory. The same also applies to any new families in our Parish who will have children in any of our Grades 1 through 9. Thank you for your cooperation.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION ... First Communion is a two-year program and students must complete first and second grades in order to make their First Communion. Confirmation is also a two-year program and students must complete eighth and ninth grades in order to make their Confirmation. Sunday and Holyday Mass attendance is also a requirement.
