NO PARKING LINES ... As mentioned in last weekend's bulletin, we have added "No Parking" yellow lines and signs at our Parish Center. The purpose of this is two-fold. Primarily, it is to keep the area in front of the door as well as the sidewalk entrances clear when Christian Formation classes are being held on Sunday mornings from 8:15AM to 10:00AM. CLASSES START THIS SUNDAY, OCTOBER 20 FOR GRADES 1 TO 8, 8:45 TO 9:45AM IN ST. PATRICK'S PARISH CENTER ... You may still register your child at this time. We will also need you to confirm that the information on your Parish Census Card is correct or fill out a new card if you are a new family in our parish. There is a \$20 per family registration fee that will help pay for your child's workbooks. Please note that we are combining the St. Patrick's and St. Mary's students for this school year. All classes will be here at St. Patrick's. Both Sue Lefebvre and Pat Gladd will be co-directors of the program.

SIGN-UP SHEETS ... Reminder that, starting next weekend, there will be sign-up sheets for Mass attendance in the upstairs church lobby for 1st Grade, 2nd Grade, 8th Grade and Confirmation Students. If you do not attend Mass here at St. Patrick's, please have the pastor at the church you attend sign a bulletin from that church and bring it to your class.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION ... First Communion is a two-year program and students must complete first and second grades in order to make their First Communion. Confirmation is also a two-year program and students must complete eighth and ninth grades in order to make their Confirmation. Sunday and Holyday Mass attendance is also a requirement.
