HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION ... Friday, November 1 (Feast of All Saints) is a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses will be at 9:00AM at St. Patrick's and 7:00PM at St. Mary's.

FIRST FRIDAY ... Friday, November 1 is First Friday at St. Patrick's. If you plan on taking an hour to adore the Blessed Sacrament on this Friday, please take the time to sign up on the sheet provided at the entrance near the sanctuary. We need to ensure that at least two people are present during the time of exposition. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will be immediately after the 9:00AM Mass and end at 11:00AM with Benediction.
