REVISED GUIDELINES FOR PARISH LIFE ... Please note that Bishop Terry R. LaValley has reinstated the obligation to attend Sunday Mass in the Diocese of Ogdensburg. With this in mind, parishioners who are fully vaccinated are not required to wear a face mask at Mass. Children under 12 who are not vaccine-eligible and those under the age of 16 who have not been vaccinated, may accompany and be seated with a vaccinated adult. Those who are not fully vaccinated should observe 6-foot social distancing and wear a face mask except when receiving Holy Communion. Hand sanitizers will still be available at the church entrances. Please note that Communion should be received in the hand only as this is the best way to ensure everyone's safety at this time. Thank you for your continued understanding and cooperation.

2020 BISHOP'S FUND APPEAL ENDS JUNE 30 ... As of June 1, 2021, the cost to open and close a grave is \$500 (\$575 if the burial takes place on the weekend). Opening and closing cremation graves is now \$200.
