NEW LAY MINISTERS FOR ST. MARY'S AND ST. PATRICK'S... We are proud to announce that on Sunday, June 27, Jeffrey and Renee Morelock will be installed by Bishop LaValley as Lay Ministers for the Diocese of Ogdensburg. They will be serving both parishes by ministering to the sick and elderly. They have completed two years of study in the Formation for Ministry Program. Congratulations, Jeff and Renee.

FIRST FRIDAY ... Friday, July 2 is First Friday at St. Mary's. If you plan on taking an hour to adore the Blessed Sacrament on this Friday, please take the time to sign up on the sheet provided on the radiator in the back of the church. We need to ensure that at least two people are present during the time of exposition. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will be immediately after the 9:00AM Mass and end at 11:00AM with Benediction.

REVISED GUIDELINES FOR PARISH LIFE ... The obligation to attend Sunday Mass in the Diocese of Ogdensburg has been reinstated. Parishioners who are fully vaccinated are not required to wear a face mask at Mass. Those who are not fully vaccinated should observe 6-feet social distancing and wear a face mask except when receiving Holy Communion. Hand sanitizers will still be available at the church entrances. Please note that Communion should be received in the hand only as this is the best way to ensure everyone's safety at this time. Thank you for your continued understanding and cooperation.
