She will also help with Christian Formation classes and serve as a Eucharistic Minister and Lector. Please introduce yourself to her so that she may get to know you.

MISSIONARY COOPERATION PLAN ... The Missionary Cooperation Plan collection, which will be taken up next weekend, will be for the religious who work here in our diocese; that is, the Sisters of the Cross of Chavanod. HEALTH AND OBLIGATION TO ATTEND MASS ... The general dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass has been lifted. However, the obligation to attend Sunday Mass does not apply to individuals who are sick, in a vulnerable category (elderly, long-term conditions such as cancer, diabetes, heart conditions, respiratory conditions, etc.), or those who continue to have significant anxiety or concerns about returning to Mass in person. The streaming of Sunday Eucharistic celebrations is being maintained for the benefit of those who are still not in a position to attend Mass in person.
