The funds collected will be used for the order's mission work in India. As always, thank you for your support and generosity.

SR. RANI SELVARAJ ... As mentioned in last weekend's bulletin, we are happy to welcome Sr. Rani to our Parishes. Sr. Rani has replaced Sr. Jessy as our Pastoral Associate. She is assigned to both St. Patrick's and St. Mary's. Sr. Rani will be visiting the seniors and shut-ins in our area, the nursing homes and the hospital in Plattsburgh. She will also help with Christian Formation classes and serve as a Eucharistic Minister and Lector. Please introduce yourself to her so that she may get to know you.

HEALTH AND OBLIGATION TO ATTEND MASS ... The general dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass has been lifted. However, the obligation to attend Sunday Mass does not apply to individuals who are sick, in a vulnerable category (elderly, long-term conditions such as cancer, diabetes, heart conditions, respiratory conditions, etc.), or those who continue to have significant anxiety or concerns about returning to Mass in person. The streaming of Sunday Eucharistic celebrations is being maintained for the benefit of those who are still not in a position to attend Mass in person.
