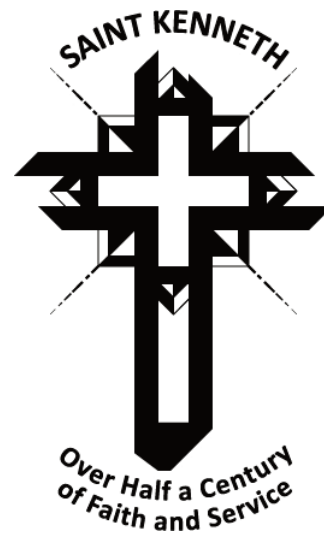
Gathering - Come to the Water, by John Foley
