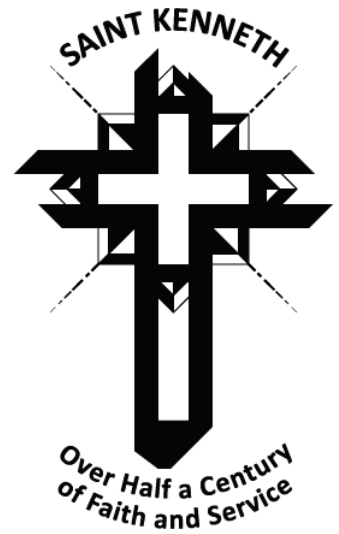


WELCOME TO SAINT KENNETH!

Gathering - Immaculate Mary, Lourdes Hymn
