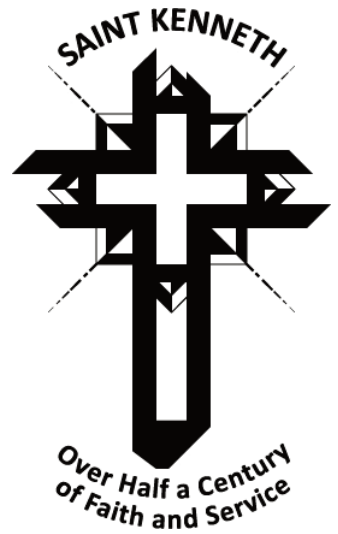


# WELCOME TO SAINT KENNETH!
