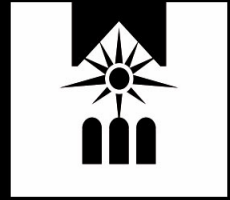

**MEDITATION
ON TODAY'S READINGS
Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

In all these things we conquer overwhelmingly. (Romans 8:37)

Julius Caesar. Alexander the Great. Napoleon Bonaparte. Genghis Khan. What do these men have in common? They were among the world's greatest conquerors. They waged military campaigns that took them far and wide, forming mighty empires along the way.

Would you include Jesus in that list? Or St. Paul? Or yourself, for that matter? We don't think of Christ, or Christians in general, as conquerors. Jesus died an ignoble death at the hands of the Romans. St. Paul was beheaded by the same empire. They looked more like the conquered than conquerors. Even today many Christians are martyred by those in power.

And yet through his sacrifice on the cross and his resurrection from the dead, Jesus conquered the greatest enemies of all: sin and death. And because of our baptism into Christ, that's a victory we all share in—no matter what befalls us in this life.

Paul's words must have comforted the early Christians whenever they experienced persecution for their faith. Even when it looked like they were "losing," they knew they were actually "winning." They trusted that not even the worst calamity could separate them from Jesus (Romans 8:39)!

These verses can bring you comfort as well. You may be experiencing the kind of anguish and distress that St. Paul described. Or maybe you are repeatedly "losing" to a certain temptation. Whatever the case, know that as you cling to the Lord, you will "win" in the end. One day Jesus will welcome you into his heavenly kingdom, and everything will be made right and beautiful.

Until then, remember that God will never separate himself from you; his love is too strong, too real and solid. And through that love, you too will triumph over sin, death, and all the trials of life. You too will be a conqueror.

CATHOLIC COMMUNICATIONS AND HUMAN DEVELOPMENT COLLECTION

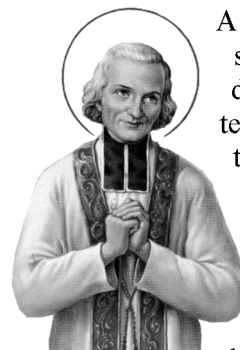
CATHOLIC CHARITIES REMOTE INTERSHIP OPPORTUNITY

SAINT JOHN MARY VIANNEY



A busy pastor jokingly suggests the secret of John Vianney's holiness: "He died seventeen years before telephones!" Call they didn't, but visit they did, keeping Vianney eighteen hours a day in the confessional. Stories abound of reading hearts and exorcisms, but Vianney's first miracle was getting ordained. Difficulty with studies delayed him, prompting the rector's apology to

the bishop, "So far to ordain just one, especially this one!" The bishop, who could not know he was ordaining the future patron saint of parish priests, replied, "No burden to ordain one good priest!" In Ars, only an elderly handful attended Mass, "praying," one told Vianney, "for a priest with brains." But he stayed forty-two years, fulfilling the promise he made the day he arrived. In a sculpture just outside the village Vianney points skyward: "Show me the way to Ars," he tells a boy, "and I'll show you the way to heaven." To someone who feared there was no heaven beyond the grave, Vianney smiled, "My child, it would have been heaven enough to have lived as Jesus' disciple on earth." (Peter Scagnelli, Copyright © J. S. [주님의 거룩한 변모] 축일 8월 6일

그리스도의 수난과 부활 이전에 있었던 예수의 영광스러운 변모를 기념하는 축일. 이 축일은 4~5세기 이래 동방교회에서 지내 왔는데, 처음에는 국부적이고 비공식적인 축일이었으나 11세기 이전에 공식적 축일로 널리 채택되었다. 서방교회에는 8세기 이래 일부지역에서 지내오다가 전 교회의 축일로 된 것은 1457년의 갈리스토(Callistus) 3세 때이며 이것은 1456년 8월 6일 벨그라드(Belgrade)에서 터키군으로부터 승리를 쟁취한 것을 기념하기 위하여 시작되었다.

주님의 거룩한 변모는 예수께서 지상생활 중 잠시 신성(神性)을 드러내심으로써 그 모습이 영광스럽게 변화되신 사건. 복음(마태 17:1-13, 마르 9:2-13, 루카 9:28-36)에 기록되고 2베드 1:18에 암시되어 있다. 이 사건의 장소 '높은 산'은 전승에 의하면 다불산이며, 그 위에 기념성당까지 세워져 있으나 이와 달리 헤르몬산 또는 올리브산이라는 학자들의 주장이 있다. 이 사건의 시기는 베드로의 말을 미루어 보아 이스라엘인 장막축제를 지내는 연중 7째달(9~10월) 15~22일경으로 보인다. 여기서 예수님은 야훼의 종 메시아에 관한 성서의 말씀을 실현하시는 주님으로 나타나시며 십자가를 통하여 부활의 영광에 이르는 파스카의 신비가 암시되어 있다.

예수의 영광스러운 변모는 그리스도 안에 있는 모든 그리스도인의 미래의 영광된 변모를 가리키는 예표이다. 그리스도인은 종말에 경험할 완벽한 '영광스러운 변모'를 기대하면서 현재에 영광스러운 변모를 거듭하도록 불려진 사람들이다(2코린 3:18). 그리스도인은 성사적인 만남으로 그리스도의 죽음과 부활의 영광에 참여하며 성령의 도우심으로 부활에 이르는 십자가의 길을 성공적으로 완주하는 것이다.

[성녀 리디아] 축일 8월 3일

티아티라 태생인 리디아는 자색 옷감장수였는데 필리피에서 행한 성 바오로의 설교에 감복하여 첫번째 개종자로서 세례를 받았다.

온집안 식구들도 영세를 받게 하였고 바오로로 하여금 자신의 집에 기거하면서 선교활동을 돕도록 하였다.(사도 16,12-15). 유럽대륙(그리스)의 첫 영세자이다.

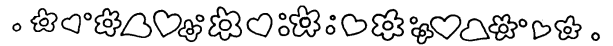
[성 요한 마리아 비안네] 축일 8월 4일

프랑스의 리옹 교외 시골 농부의 아들로 태어난 비안네 성인(1786-1859년)은 신학교 성적이 부진하여 장래를 기약할 수 없을 정도였으나 어떤 자격보다도 훌륭한 신심과 좋은 의지를 참작한 교회가 그를 사제로 서품함으로써 한 성인의 탄생을 바라보게 된 것이다.

그는 한적한 시골인 아르스의 주임사제로 부임하면서부터 단순한 설교와 충실한 고해신부로 이름이 퍼져나가, 마침내 조용한 시골을 프랑스 신앙의 중심지로 바꿔 놓은 것이다. 그는 하루에 열 여덟 시간이나 고백소에서 지냈고 그의 설교는 단순하지만 심금을 울리는 내용이었다.

그의 동료 사제들은 그를 오해하여 "무식하고 지나치게 열성적인 허풍쟁이"라고 힐난했으나 그의 주교는 "저 신부만큼 모든 사제들이 미쳤으면 좋겠다"고 하면서 옹호하였고 한다. 성인은 단지 세 번 아르스를 떠났는데, 그 모두가 수도원을 잠깐씩 다녀오는 것이 전부였다.

그는 과로로 운명하였다. 1929년 교황 비오 11세께서 그를 본당 사제의 수호자로 선언하였다.



[성 도미니코] 축일 8월 8일

스페인인 칼라루에가에서 태어난 도미니코 구즈만은 팔렌시아에서 수학하던 중에 그곳에서 서품된 듯 하며, 1203년부터 오스마의 주교를 수행하여 알비파 이단을 상대로 설교하여 상당한 성공을 거두었고, 또 시토회의 개혁을 도왔다.

후일 그는 여섯 명의 동료들과 함께 알비파의 회개를 목적으로 하는 활동 수도회를 창설하여, 교황 호노리오 3세로부터 승인을 받음으로써 설교회 곧 도미니코회가 그 고고한 첫발을 내디딘 것이다. 도미니코회는 지성적인 생활과 대중의 요구를 잘 조화시켰던만큼 회개운동을 꾸준히 전개하는데 큰 성공을 거둘 수 있었다. 그는 1220년에 볼로냐에서 수도회의 첫 총회를 소집하여 조직을 강화한 다음, 이듬해 8월 6일에 그곳에서 운명하였다. 성인은 헝가리에서 행한 순회 설교에서 얻은 병으로 고생하다가 생을 마감한 것이다.

도미니코는 1234년에 시성되었고, 천문학자의 수호 성인으로 큰 공경을 받고 있다.
