How many nights a week do our families share a meal? sports, work, clubs, social activity... then, Faith Formation for our children. For some families taking up three separate nights a week. Our families are being pulled in every conceivable direction. We all know it. After the presentation, children will break into small groups by grade level. Each evening will end with a hands-on prayer activity, something that brings the lesson for the night to life, something that will really live in the memory of our children.
