Dear St. Paul Families,

Many thanks to everyone for being extremely cautious with illness in your family and with your child. It's crucial that we work for the good of the whole in keeping everyone well. I know it may be inconvenient to keep your child at home when they have cold symptoms or a runny nose, but this will help to reduce spread of illness and assist us in keeping the children learning at school. One of the key components of reducing the spread of illness is to stay home when you don't feel well. I thank you in advance for your assistance.

Here is some information and guidance on symptoms and when to keep students home, when to seek medical advice, and when to seek testing:

- People with COVID-19 can have a wide range of symptoms, ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2–14 days after exposure to the virus. The “primary” COVID-19 symptoms require exclusion from school. The “non-primary” COVID-19 symptoms can be seen with many other illnesses, in addition to COVID-19. The non-primary symptoms do not always require exclusion.
- When feasible, ill students with any primary COVID-19 symptoms will be encouraged to seek viral testing. If a student has non-primary symptoms that persist for more than one day, parents should consider evaluation by the child's healthcare provider who can determine if viral testing is advised.

#### Primary COVID-19 symptoms:

- Cough • Fever • Chills • Shortness of breath
- Difficulty breathing • New loss of taste or smell

#### Non-primary COVID-19 symptoms:

- Fatigue • Muscle or body aches • Headache • Sore throat • Nasal congestion or runny nose • Nausea or vomiting • Diarrhea

The following is the definition of exposure. These are the directives from ODE, OHA and LCPH that the school is using when determining if other students are a close contact of a COVID-19 case.

**“Exposure definition:** *There is now an exception to the exposure definition (having been within 6 feet of a confirmed or presumptive COVID-19 case for 15 minutes or more within one day) for the K–12 indoor classroom setting: students who were within 3 to 6 feet of someone with COVID-19 where both students were engaged in consistent and correct use of well-fitting masks and other K–12 school prevention strategies (such as universal and correct mask use, physical distancing, increased ventilation) were in place are not considered exposed.”*

Everyone continues to do a great job to reduce the risks here at the school. We will continue to work diligently with our staff and students to mitigate possible risks at St. Paul.

Today, teachers will participate in a full day of professional development. I ask that you keep us in your prayers. May we further develop our craft in order to implement best teaching practices and learning opportunities for our students.

I hope that you all enjoy your three-day weekend!
