Cohort B: 12:00pm – 12:10pm

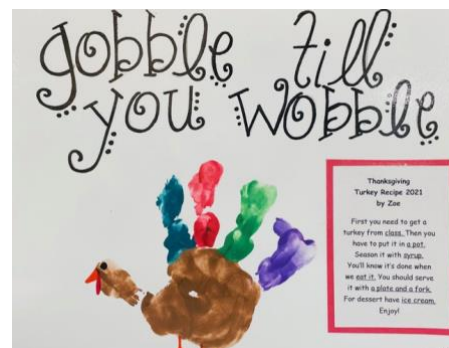
COVID INFORMATION
