FOURTEENTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME: GOD REVEALS HIMSELF TO THE SIMPLE

Jesus had no problem with simple people. These humble men and women joyfully embraced God the Father's message, he was concerned for all his children but overall, for those that were forgotten. They want His blessings, being with Jesus they felt that God was closer to them. Many sick persons, animated by their faith in the good God, began to believe once more in the Heavenly Father. People felt as Jesus spoke that he was talking about the God which they needed, they experienced the Father's salvation near them.

On the other hand are the ones who knew the law, those who were in teaching positions and upheld the law. They didn't receive Him the same way: How could he worry about these people so much and not keep the law? They feel that this Good News is going against how they live their religion. Jesus see this, he knows them, He hoped they would be different and understand, but they did no. Jesus' words move us: *"I give praise to you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, for although you have hidden these things from the wise and the learned you have revealed them to little ones. Yes, Father, such has been your gracious will."* Today the same things happen, the poor are always open to the Lord, that he is walking with them all the time; to also having His dear Mother, our Mother, with us on our journey. That is why it is important for all to have a voice in the Church and in our world. How can we have a real Church, if the poor and marginalized; children, women and men have no voice? They all have to have a voice and all have to be a part of it. Pope Francis and many others are teaching us to return to the beginning, return to the simple life, just as Jesus lived and showed us. They are teaching us to be more cohesion and less on only the doctrinal. Make it a reality in our words and actions, living in that Spirit that moves us and takes us to proclaim, to celebrate our church life as some dynamic and living that speaks to all, especially to those who Jesus loved more.

DÉCIMO CUARTO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO: DIOS SE REVELA A LOS SENCILLOS

Jesús no tuvo problemas con la gente sencilla. Aquellas gentes humildes acogían con gozo su mensaje de un Dios Padre, preocupado de todos sus hijos, sobre todo, de los más olvidados. Ellos buscaban su bendición, porque junto a Jesús sentían a Dios más cercano. Muchos enfermos, animados por su fe en un Dios bueno, volvían a confiar en el Padre del cielo. El pueblo sentía que Jesús, con su forma de hablar de Dios, anunciaba al Dios que ellos necesitaban, ellos experimentaban la cercanía salvadora de Padre.

En el otro lado están los entendidos de la ley, los que estaban en puesto de enseñanza y de mantener la ley. Ellos no lo acogían de esa misma manera: ¿cómo es que se preocupa tanto por éstos y tan poco en cumplir con la ley. Esa Buena Noticia para ellos es algo que justo va en contra de su forma de vivir la religión. A Jesús no le cuesta ver esto, él los conoce, ya quisiera que fueran diferentes y entendiesen, pero ellos no ceden. Por eso nos mueve esta afirmación de Jesús: *«Te doy gracias, Padre, Señor del cielo y de la tierra, porque has escondido estas cosas a los sabios y entendidos y las has dado a conocer a los sencillos. Sí, Padre, así te ha parecido mejor»*. Hoy a veces pasa lo mismo, los pobres están abiertos siempre a al Señor, a su caminar con ellos en todo momento. A tener también a su querida Madre, nuestra Madre, ahí en nuestro caminar. Por eso es importante que todos tengan voz en la Iglesia y en el mundo. ¿Cómo podemos hacer una verdadera Iglesia, si los mismos pobres, marginados, niños, mujeres, hombres, no tienen una voz y ni sienten parte de ella? El Papa Francisco y muchos otros nos están enseñando a regresar al principio, regresar a la sencillez de vida, tal como Jesús vivió y os enseñó. Nos están enseñando a vivir más en coherencia y mucho menos a la sola doctrina. Es hacerlo palabra y vida, es vivir con el Espíritu que nos mueve a ir y proclamar, a celebrar la vida eclesial como algo verdaderamente dinámico y vivo que habla a todos, pero sobre todo a los que más amó Jesús.
