THIRTEENTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME: CAUSE YOU GOT TO HAVE FAITH!

As I was reflecting on this Sunday's reading from Mark and on our celebrations last weekend, my mind kept reminding me of the importance of having faith. We have these persons who have great faith in Jesus, in His power and desire to help those in need. They may have a feeling of unworthiness, but their need of healing takes them to the Messiah. Jairus is looking for a miracle for his dying daughter and the unnamed woman who's hemorrhage was unstoppable. Both came from different part of society, one a chief of the synagogue, the other a humble woman who as a woman was completely defenseless before all. They both see in the person of Jesus the one who could completely change their situations. Neither stop themselves from approaching and putting themselves lowly before him, both prove that their faith is greater than their fear, position or sinfulness.

My brothers and sisters, we have come a long way. As I think of the changes that this church of ours has encountered, I also think there might have been or can be moments of fear. A lot of the different things that were happening here are not here anymore. You have seen the changes. Saint John's University, St. John's Prep, St. John's Bread and Life, the Diocesan Seminary, our schools have closed or have been transformed. We don't have 75 Lewis anymore, all this can make us think and say: what's going on? Well if we are a people of faith, we can't lose sight that life brings challenges, some are life changing, crosses that can get overwhelming and many times those that surround us, even in Church, don't always offer solutions or help. When it all seems lost, we must turn to the Lord. We should always turn to the Lord, but we know as human beings we tend to go all over, confide in the world, confide in our own strength and capacities, instead of going to the source of all blessings. May we never let anyone, or anything keep us from Him. From praying for our needs and the needs of the world, from looking to Him for guidance, for strength, for all we live.

Nuestras escuelas han cerrado o se han transformado. No tenemos al edificio del 75 de Lewis, todo esto nos puede llevar a pensar ¿qué está pasando? Pero si somos personas de fe, no podemos perder de vista que la vida trae retos, algunos cambian nuestras vidas, cruces que pueden abrumarnos y muchas veces lo que nos rodean, aún en la iglesia, no nos ofrecen soluciones ni ayuda. Cuando todo parece que está perdido, tenemos que ir al Señor. Debemos siempre ir al Señor, pero sabemos que como humanos que somos, vamos por todo lugar, confiamos en el mundo, confiamos sobre nuestras propias fuerzas y capacidades, en vez de ir a la fuente de bendiciones. Nunca dejemos que nada ni nadie no mantenga lejos del Señor. De orar por nuestras necesidades y las del mundo, de buscarle para dirección, Fortaleza, por todo lo que vivimos.

HOLY SACRAMENTS

Infant Baptism Birth to 6 yrs.

Infant baptisms are celebrated on the first Sunday of every month. Baptism preparation class for parents and Godparents are held on the Tuesday prior to the Baptism Sunday. Parent(s) or Godparent(s), please bring an original birth certificate of the child to the main office where you can begin the process of registration for this beautiful sacrament.

Children's Faith Formation ages 7 yrs. to 15 yrs.

(Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation)

Our Children's Faith Formation program provides preparation of the Holy Sacraments for children. The program follows Diocesan Guidelines for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Children. The hours for children's faith formation classes are Sunday, 9:30 A.M. -1:00 P.M.

Pentecost Confirmation 16 yrs. and older

Are you baptized and received First Holy Communion but have not completed the Sacrament of Confirmation and you are over the age of 16? Our Confirmation only program begins in January in preparation for Pentecost Confirmation typically at the end of May or beginning of June.

Anointing of the sick

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.)

(Becoming a Catholic)

Are you baptized? Have you received First Holy Communion? Are you Confirmed? Adults and youth at least 16 yrs. of age seeking **full initiation** into the Catholic Church are invited to enter into a process of faith formation. RCIA classes are all year round.

Sacrament of Marriage

(Getting Married in the Church)

For a marriage ceremony at St. John the Baptist or Our Lady of Good Counsel, arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least 1 year before the wedding date.
