- I will only pursue peaceful solutions to the violence of abortion when volunteering with the Houston Coalition for Life

- I understand that acting in a violent or harmful manner immediately and completely disassociates me from the Houston Coalition for Life and Stand & Pray campaigns
- I am in no way associated with Planned Parenthood or its affiliates by way of employment, informant, volunteer, client, or otherwise

While standing in the city right of way in front of (abortion facility or Planned Parenthood location):

- I will not obstruct the driveways or sidewalk while standing in the public right of way
- I will not litter on the public right of way
- I will closely attend to any children I bring to the prayer vigil
- I will not threaten, physically contact, or verbally abuse (abortion facility or Planned Parenthood) employees, volunteers, or customers
- I will not vandalize private property
- I will cooperate with local city authorities

While the Houston Coalition for Life agrees there are appropriate times and places for graphic signs and pictures, we do not believe that abortion facilities are an appropriate venue. They can become a deterrent for young women who are looking for help, assistance, and compassion. It is important that we maintain an approachable, peaceful presence in order to encourage her to stop and speak with those offering her help at the last possible moment. The Houston Coalition for Life can provide you with an appropriate sign if you would like to hold one.
