

Virtual Class Rules & Expectations

Welcome to the 2020-2021 school year! We are looking forward to a wonderful year with you!

Below are rules and expectations that must be followed while completing remote classes:

- Each day you must join your **homeroom zoom for attendance by 8 am**. You will be marked late after 8:15 am. Following your homeroom class schedule, you must sign into your teacher's zoom for each class. (Example: If you have Math at 9:00 am, you must sign into Mrs. Melia's zoom to be sure you are present for Math Class that day.) Be sure you are prepared and ready to learn for each class!
- **Class participation** counts!
 - **ALL classwork** must be submitted through Google Classroom, and submitted to the appropriate teacher.
 - **Complete ALL homework** each night—make sure you write down your homework when it is announced in class and then use your other resources such as google classroom if you missed the homework for the day.
 - When completing your classwork and/or homework, complete it to the best of your ability so it reflects your understanding of the topic. When confused on a part, ask questions (email or other resources) but always give an answer—never leave blanks.
 - Incomplete homework will result in loss of points from homework grade.
 - Incorrect pages/assignments will be counted as incomplete.
 - Make sure to **stay focused and be positive!**
- **Tests/Quizzes:**
 - Tests will be announced ahead of time.
 - Tests must be completed
 - Some **quizzes may be unannounced**, but will always reflect the lesson or past lessons taught.
 - All tests/quizzes must be completed within the time allotted for that class. All tests/quizzes must be submitted to Google classroom or through Google forms.
Students must be present on zoom with their video on while completing their test.
 - Tests and quizzes will be returned after everyone completes the assessment, and grades will be entered on the online grading system, Educate.
 - The use of other devices and/or classroom notes is strongly discouraged while completing tests/quizzes remotely.
