Grade 2 Cumulative Schedule/Exam Outline

Dear Parents,

We will be taking a cumulative test in both reading and math. The test dates are as follows:

- Reading Cumulative Exam - Wednesday, January 20th.
- Math Cumulative Exam - Friday, January 22nd.

The reading exam will consist mainly of reading comprehension passages. It will also include a few phonics, grammar, and spelling questions. The best way to study for reading comprehension is to continue reading daily.

The math test will include questions from all the topics we have learned so far this year. I will be modeling the midterm closely with the review assignment given over the break, as well as the assignments to come when we return to school.

The following topics will all be included on the test:

- Basic addition and subtraction word problems
- Double digit addition with regrouping (we will be finishing when we return to school)
- Adding up to four numbers
- Odd and even numbers
- Repeated addition number sentences
- Place value- hundreds, tens, and ones
- Skip counting – 2's, 5's, 10's
- Expanded form, standard form and word form
- Greater than, less than, equal to
- Mentally add or subtract 10 or 100

Be sure to review the math homework assignment given over break as well as the assignments marked “Review Assignments” when we return to school after the break. They should also review compound words, statements, questions, exclamations, complete sentences, nouns, plural nouns, possessive nouns, verbs, and phonics covered by spelling rules. This can all be found in your child’s ELA notebook or through sheets in the reading folder.

We will be reviewing these things when we return home from vacation. Don’t worry too much!
