Dear Parents,

I am writing to give you some information about our first few days. Remote students MUST have parents sign and return the technology permission form. This is needed to have students participate in our zoom class. I will attach it in this email for you to print and sign. I will also "assign" it to your student in Google classroom. You can sign it and submit it through Google classroom or you can email it to me. Students who are in person can also bring these signed forms tomorrow. If you are coming to class and forget to bring it, a form will be put in your child's folder to sign and return the next day.

Please remember to bring the daily health checklist tomorrow morning. Have it in your child's hand and ready for Mrs. Falabella or the person who checks your child's temperature. No one will be allowed in the building without a signed form.

Also, as we are still testing technology and also will be going over many social distancing practices and handwashing protocols, we will only have the remote students sign in for an hour tomorrow, September 9th. The remote hours will be 9:15- 10:15 tomorrow. On Thursday, September 10th, we will have students sign on an hour before lunch and an hour after lunch. As lunch hours differ, please note that different grades may be signing in at different times this Thursday ONLY. Second grade will be on from 9:40- 10:40 to allow for handwashing before our 10:50 lunch period. Students will then come back to their computers from 11:30 until 12:30.

I have posted pictures of our classroom and hallway setup on our school class page. If you would like to see how we are spaced out, please check our class page. This page will also have homework and messages posted daily!

Some of you have asked about picking up books and supplies for remote students. No date or time has been set yet, as most books have not arrived at school. I will keep you posted when all books are delivered.

Finally, if you have not signed your child into our Google Classroom, please join using the class code mysqkoi as soon as possible! Thank you and I look forward to seeing you tomorrow.
