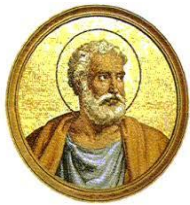

🕯 **3rd Candle** ~ (pink) The Shepherd Candle or The Candle of Joy. The angels sang a message of JOY! "...and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son.
