**Advent Confessions** ~ Due to COVID -19 we have been advised not to have our annual Advent Confessions with visiting priests. If you would like to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation, it is available 30 minutes prior to all Masses (including weekday), by appointment or last chance Saturday Dec. 19, 10 am until noon ☺

**Christmas Mass Update:** Upon directives of the Archdiocese of Kingston and local Health Units, the following procedures will be followed for all Christmas Masses. The 4 pm Christmas Eve Mass, also known as 'the Children's Mass' is specifically intended for families, especially those with young children and those that live in their 'bubble'. Masks, hand sanitization & social distancing will be enforced. Please respect these directives.

When the church has reached it's 30% allowable capacity, the doors will be locked and Mass will begin. When coming to the pew you intend to occupy, please move to the centre of the pew, so others can have a place to sit. It is highly recommended that those who wish to avoid crowds attend later masses in the evening or else attend Christmas Day Mass. ~ *Thank you for your co-operation*

**COVID-19 Update** ~ Our most recent update from the Archdiocese of Kingston commends your efforts to implement the Worship safe protocols that we have implemented in our church. "Furthermore, with the increase in numbers of COVID-19 cases at this time, the reception of Communion needs to be in the hand and not on the tongue. Physical distancing remains an important protocol for Communicants and when receiving Communion, masks are to be removed" as per Archbishop Mulhall. We also remind you to please leave your kneelers down where you have been sitting so that those great volunteers who sanitize the church know where to clean. *Thank you*
