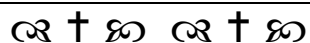

**Abstinence and Fasting**

All Catholics who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday are bound to abstain entirely from meat on **Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent**. All Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are bound to observe the laws of **fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday**. Fasting means limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Two other light meals, which together do not equal a full meal, may be taken during the day
