## Letter from Michael Mulhall Archbishop of Kingston

June 2021 My dear Faithful of the Archdiocese: Today, we begin the month of June, which is traditionally dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. I am inviting you to join with me in dedicating ourselves in private prayer, and as a community, to this precious mystery. The continued restrictions resulting from the pandemic will make our communal celebrations difficult. However, it is my prayer that, before the end of the month, we will be in a better position to enjoy much greater freedom to gather. His Eminence Cardinal Thomas Collins, the Archbishop of Toronto, has prepared a beautiful pastoral letter on the Sacred Heart, which I have sent as an attachment with this letter. I ask that each of you take the time to read his gift to each of us and reflect on the mystery of God's self-revelation to humanity. May this reflection during the month of June allow us—and our Catholic groups and institutions—to move closer to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Be assured of my continued prayers for each of you during these difficult times.

Cardinal Collins on the Sacred Heart

**Sun., June 11** ~ Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is one of the most popular Catholic devotions. Although it was beloved in previous centuries, Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1673, showing her a vision of the now-famous image of His Sacred Heart, surrounded by flames. He said to her: "My Heart is so full of love for men that It can no longer contain the flames of Its burning love. I must discover to men the treasures of My Heart and save them from perdition." She was given the special mission to spread devotion to His Sacred Heart throughout the Church. Jesus gave St. Margaret Mary many promises associated with this devotion, and requested that a feast day in honor of His Sacred Heart be instituted on the Friday after the Octave of Corpus Christi. In 1856, the Feast of the Sacred Heart was spread to the Universal Church, and in 1899 Pope Leo XIII solemnly consecrated all mankind to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, calling it "the great act" of his pontificate.
