K of C Virtual Walkathon Fundraiser



Dust off those sneakers and treadmills. **If you take a walk or do a run every day this is for you.**

The Knights of Columbus St Peter's Council 2438 Trenton Ont. are sponsoring a Virtual Walkathon/Run starting on October 12th to October 31st. The goal is for the group to collectively log enough kms to virtually walk/run from St Peter's council in Trenton to reach St Peter's Council 8910, Mary Esther Florida a total distance of 2,094 kms over a period of 20 days.

First come first serve, registration will be capped at 30 virtual "walkers/runners" to make the challenge enjoyable and manageable over the run period. To reach our goal will require participants to cover 3.5 kms a day on average. Some will cover less while others will cover more. Registration is open to brothers Knights, family or friends.

Registration fee is \$10 and participants need to obtain donors willing to sponsor them a flat amount for their contribution to the virtual walk/run. Pledges of any amount are welcome. Pledges of \$25 or more will qualify for a tax receipt from the Knights of Columbus (Registration No. 88913-4573RR001). A \$50 prize will go to the registered walker/runner who collects the most pledges.

Participants must keep track of their daily dedicated walk or run distance for this event **(not total steps taken during the day)** and report their results to the run coordinator each Sunday. The run coordinator will combine the individual distances and plot the weekly total kms on the route map to show where the group is relative to the destination.

Participants are responsible to collect their pledges following the walk and submit the pledges and entry fee by Nov 5th. Any cheques should be made payable to the Knights of Columbus.

Registration period starts now and ends at noon on Sept 30th or when 30 registrations are received by the run coordinator whichever occurs first. Participants have until the October 12th walk/run start date to obtain pledges for the walk.

A registration/pledge form is attached. The first 30 forms received before noon on Sept 30th qualify. **Proceeds will go to Hospice Quinte.** This is a fundraiser that everyone can support. If you cannot register as a "walker/runner" you can pledge an amount to a registered runner. If you don't know who to pledge contact the run coordinator.
