- Hymnals, missals, and prayer books may be returned to pews.
- Dr. Cook, advisor to The Association of Catholic Bishops of Ontario, has concluded that it is permissible to resume singing since masks are in place; the choir is already distanced from each other and the congregation. Parishioners are expected to be symptom free.

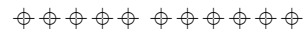
