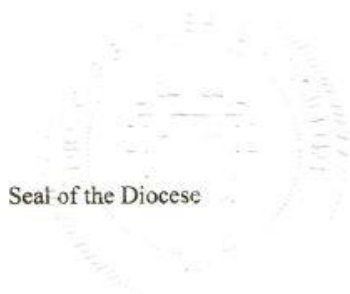
DECREE

I, Most Reverend David A. Konderla, Bishop of Tulsa, having considered the recommendations of public health officials to reduce the number of persons attended public gatherings and in consultation with the Presbyteral Council, decree:

That all public Masses within the Diocese of Tulsa are suspended from March 20th until April 8th, 2020 (unless revoked or extended by subsequent decree), and

That the faithful are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and other holy days of obligation and are asked to make other acts of a spiritual devotion such as the Liturgy of the Hours, meditation on the Holy Scriptures, praying with a televised or streamed broadcasting of the Mass, and praying the for the sick and the vulnerable.
