Dear Parents,

Welcome to the New Year! I know this one will probably fly by even more quickly than the last, if that's possible. As you will see by the attached calendar, it's going to be a busy month. We look forward to spending this time with our students. Our first semester was a very successful one. All first semester report cards will be sent home during the week of January 8.

We spent some time this week reminding the students about procedures, and we have one reminder for adults as well. Please pay close attention in the parking lot! Sometimes we all get distracted and our primary mission outside at dismissal time is to keep everyone safe. One way you can help us do this is to pick your students up either at the flagpole or under the portico at the entrance to the school--NOT at the gym. Thank you to everyone who completed our recent parent satisfaction survey. We received some wonderful feedback that will help us to guide the school to be stronger every year. We would like to share with you some of the responses we received in the survey.

We had 83 participants, which is up from the 76 who participated last year. The Net Promoter Score, which gauges the number of parents who would recommend Trinity to others, is in the Outstanding range. We asked how satisfied you were with particular components of the school. Those average scores are below.
