A TIME FOR HEALING-ANNULMENTS: Bishop Jugis has appointed **Don Cattaneo** as the Advocate for St. William and IHM. **THE TRIBUNAL** of the Diocese of Charlotte processed over **400** annulments last year of which **98%** were approved. In addition, the Diocese of Charlotte's Tribunal announced the elimination of annulment fees (\$75 for informal and \$500 for formal annulments) effectively immediately in keeping with Pope Francis suggestion.
