Dear friends in the Lord,

I pray that you and your families had a wonderful Christmas. It has been my prayer all month that JOY may reign in our lives and overflow wherever we may find

ourselves. This weekend amidst the Christmas season we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family. This feast invites us to reflect on the experience lived by Mary, Joseph and Jesus as they grow together as a family in mutual love and in trust in God.

By presenting Jesus in the temple, Mary and Joseph are emphasizing that God alone is the Lord of all; everything comes to us from Him. Each family is called to acknowledge this primacy by protecting and educating children to open themselves to God who is the very source of life. One way that we can do this is by promoting holy and healthy vocations in the family. The family is the very seedbed of vocations in which that calling is nurtured and receives growth. This weekend I have been back and forth with a Vocation Discernment Retreat run by our seminarians for high school and college-age guys. Please pray for these young men so that they can grow in their relationship with the Lord and receive clarity in where the Lord is calling them.

I would also like to ask for your prayers for our college students from VU and from around the nation who are gathering this next week for a conference called SLS 2020. Adam and I will be leaving on Monday with about 20 college students from here in order to join probably 10,000 others. Each day will feature opportunities for prayer, time for fellowship, inspirational speakers and targeted sessions to encourage and equip these students for missionary discipleship, no matter where they find themselves. 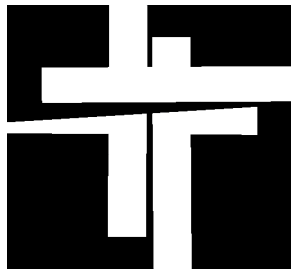
