As you know, we will be having an Outdoor Mass in Central Park next weekend on Sunday, August 30 at 11:00 AM with Bishop McClory. We will still have the Saturday evening Mass and livestream, but the outdoor Mass will be it for Sunday. For those of you who are unable to make it to Central Park, or perhaps don't feel comfortable yet, the Mass will be livestreamed to the best of our ability at 11:00 AM on the main Facebook page for St. Teresa.

The Valpo Parks Department has been great! They have assured us that there should be no problem with being able to have physical distance between households for everyone in attendance. We are asking that you RSVP at saintt.com and that you bring your own chairs so that we can maintain a safe environment.

We also are asking that:

- You arrive at least 15 minutes early.
- You enter through the east end of the Pavilion (nearest the park)
- You wear a mask throughout the entirety of the liturgy
- You sanitize your hands upon entry
- You maintain physical distance between households

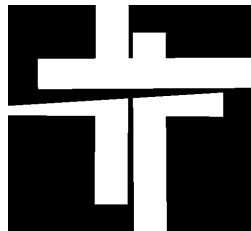

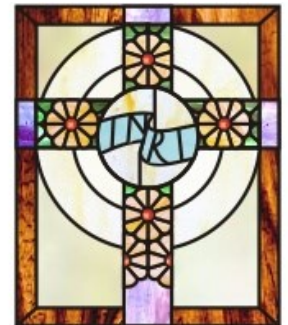
Please keep Bob and Barb Stark in your prayers as they mourn the loss of Bob's mom, Agnes Marposon.

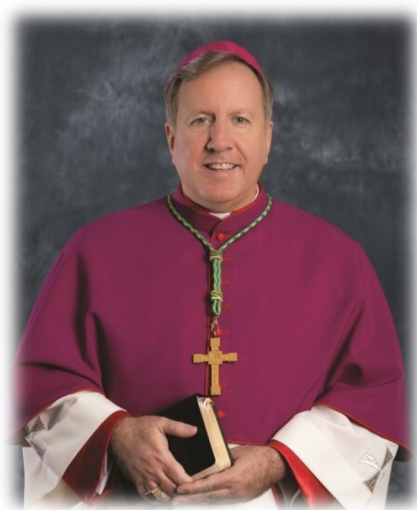
