David Rouch was born in Vicksburg, MS and was baptized at St. Michael Catholic Church where he would later make his First Communion and be confirmed by Bishop William Houck. He attended St. Francis and St. Aloysius before graduating from Vicksburg High School in 1990. He went on to graduate from Louisiana Tech University in 1996 with a Bachelor's Degree in Electrical Engineering. At that time he went to work for Commercial Metals Company at their Magnolia, Arkansas operations and became active in both his new Church and his new community.

David served his parish community in Magnolia as a Lector and Eucharistic Minister, a Catechist in children's, adult and youth ministries, as a Director of Religious Education, Director of the RCIA process, VBS volunteer, and Chairman of the Parish Council (at different times, of course!). He is a fourth degree member of the Knights of Columbus and served the last four years as the Catholic Campus Minister to Southern Arkansas University. In 2017, he received a Bachelor's of Arts Degree in Theology from St. Gregory's University in Shawnee, OK and in 2018 applied for and was accepted as a Candidate for the Permanent Diaconate for the Diocese of Little Rock. Later that same year, He and his wife Ann made the decision to move back to Vicksburg to be closer to his parents and Bishop Joseph Kopaz accepted him as a Candidate for the Permanent Diaconate for the Diocese of Jackson. He is currently employed as a System's Engineer at Grand Gulf Nuclear Power Station.

David and Ann were married in 2001 and have four adult children: Reece, Destin, Meredith and Conner; and one grandson, James David and one more on the way.
