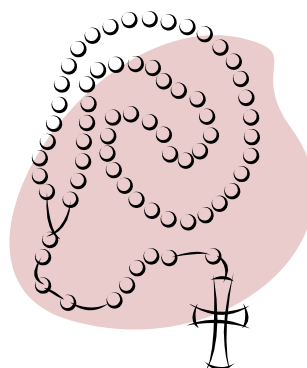
LIVING ROSARY
