**THE ASSUMPTION**

Wednesday, August 15 is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a holy day of obligation. Mass will be offered on Wednesday at 7:00 am, 8:30 am, Noon and 7:00 pm. God, in a singular way, gave the Blessed Mother the joy of being raised to heaven, both body and soul, at the end of her life on earth. If you are looking for a sign of hope in your life, come and celebrate our hope of sharing in Christ's Risen Life, a Life that his mother now enjoys forever!

**BIBLE STUDY: THE GOSPEL OF LUKE**

**DEVOTION TO THE SACRED HEART**

This week our next stained glass window is scheduled to be installed. The window was made in Austria in the 1930s and was originally placed in St. Peter Canisius church on North Avenue in Chicago. The scene in the window portrays Jesus appearing to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. St. Margaret Mary received many graces from the loving Sacred Heart of Jesus; she then became a great proponent of devotion to the Sacred Heart. I hope that as the sunlight pours through this beautiful window, we realize more and more the love that is poured upon us from the Sacred Heart of Jesus. My thanks to the family that donated the funds for this window to be cleaned, re-leaded and installed for the glory of God.

**PAINTING THE CHURCH WALLS**

I mentioned at the end of each Mass last weekend that we would like to proceed with painting the north and south walls of the church. Presently those walls are simply white; the drywall is there covering the vents that carry the warm and cool air into the church. One possible color for the walls is green, the same green that is in the ceiling and in the sanctuary. However, a number of people raised concerns that the green paint will make the church too dark, especially once the natural light is limited by the addition of more stained glass. So we will try some more samples of different colors and see what looks best before proceeding.

Father Viet Nguyen (Archdiocese of Kansas City, KS) and Father Andy Upah (Archdiocese of Dubuque, IA) were ordained earlier this year, and each priest had a special deacon assisting at his Mass of Thanksgiving - his dad. "I've always heard that the best way a father can show his kids what a man should be is to love their mother. My dad's love for my mom shows me how to be a man and also a priest, to love my bride who is the church," Father Viet said. "But it's become this circular thing where my dad has influenced my whole life, but my vocation to the priesthood influenced his pursuit of the diaconate. He told me that if I could make a commitment to give my life, he couldn't push off his calling any longer."



Both priests are quick to point to the strong faith example set by their parents as integral to their vocation. Prayer was a large part of family life, and even from an early age, both the Upahs and Nguyens could see a calling to the priesthood in their sons.
