LEARN MORE ABOUT THE PASSION AND RESURRECTION

As you may be aware, a group of thirty people have been studying the Gospel of Luke since September. In February, we will be looking at Luke's account of Jesus' passion, death and resurrection. For anyone who would like to know more about these core beliefs of our faith, you are invited to join us on Tuesday evenings (February 12, 19, 26) at 7:00 pm or Wednesday mornings (February 13, 20, 27) at 9:15 am. No prior study is necessary. Our sessions include reading the text, a twenty minute video by a theologian about the text and some discussion led by me. You can join us for one, two or all three sessions. All meetings will be in the Fellowship Hall.

THIRSTING FOR PRAYER

If you would like to know more about why and how to pray, I invite you to join me this Monday, February 18 at 9:15 am in the Fellowship Hall (lower level of the church). Many people are "thirsting for prayer", quiet time with the Lord that deepens our life together with God. Yet we can be frustrated when we struggle with establishing a steady, regular pattern of prayer in our daily lives. This one-hour presentation is meant to help with "rebooting" our prayer lives. Helpful resources will be distributed. Please join us and bring a friend.

A PROPERTY REPORT

As you may know, St. Raphael parish owns about 23 acres of land which includes our beautiful church and parking lot. To the south of the church is where I dwell and our offices are located in a 100-year-old farmhouse. There are also several barns and a parking lot. The farmhouse, barns and land are owned by the Catholic Cemeteries of Chicago. They very graciously allow us the use of the property (with the understanding that St. Raphael maintains the buildings) until the day comes when St. Raphael parish provides for our own offices and housing. This week an engineer from the Catholic Cemeteries office came out at my request to inspect the farmhouse and barns. The buildings are in good shape, but we will put some new supports in the basement of the farmhouse this winter. Beginning this winter, I will be discussing with the parish council and finance council what plans we might consider for permanent office space for St. Raphael. Stay tuned for more information, and thank you for your ongoing support for our parish.

SCHOOL SUPPORT

I am very glad that the families of St. Raphael are committed to sharing our Catholic faith with our youth. We have about 160 children registered in our Religious Education program that meets on Wednesday evenings; there are a number of families that home-school their children and we have 20 children from our parish who are attending a Catholic school in our area. Each year, St. Raphael parish gives financial support to area Catholic schools attended by children from St. Raphael. I deeply appreciate those who use the School Support envelope in your packet to contribute to the fund out of which we support Catholic education. The fact that we offer such support is an important factor in families with school-age children deciding to register at St. Raphael. Thanks to all who make families with children feel most welcome at St. Raphael.

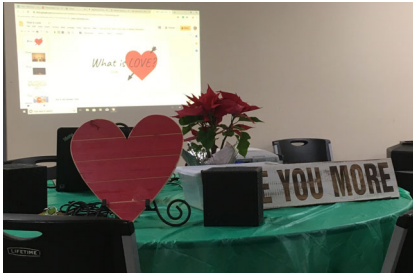
ST. PATRICK PARTY

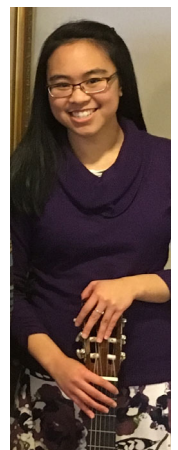

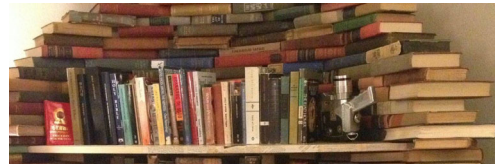
