### **O MOST HOLY TRINITY**

This Sunday is Trinity Sunday. For many people the mystery of the Holy Trinity, that God is not a solitary divine force but a community of three Divine Persons, is difficult to understand. My friend Father Tom McDermott, OP, offers this good summary of the mystery of the Trinity:

*In the interior life of God, the Father pours out His life to the Son and the Son does the same for the Father. Each points to the Other, speaks of the Other and lives for the Other. The Holy Spirit is, by analogy, the love that the two share. Because we are made in God's image and likeness, we are not meant to be focused on ourselves but outwardly directed toward others, and, in a supreme way, directed to God. We are meant to live for others and especially for God. Only by living in this way will we ever find ourselves and become the beautiful people that God made us.*

One of the ways to deepen our faith that God is a Holy Trinity is to pray to the Holy Trinity. I encourage you to say the "Glory Be" prayer frequently. While most Catholics know the "Our Father" and the "Hail Mary", there has been a real drop in the number of Catholics who know this prayer: Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be. Amen."

### **TOUR OF MUNDELEIN**

I am surprised how many people in our area have never been on the grounds of Mundelein Seminary even though it is so close to us. I am organizing a tour that would take place on either Tuesday July 23 or Wednesday July 24. We could car pool from St. Raphael's parking lot or meet at the seminary parking lot. The day would begin around 9:45 and include a guided tour of the Chapel of the Immaculate Conception, the Library and the Museum in the Administration Building. We could walk the grounds and enjoy the scenery by the small lake on the campus. Lunch would be available for \$12 in the Refectory. **HOLY COMMUNION UNDER BOTH SPECIES**

In our Catholic faith, we believe that during the consecration of the Mass, the bread and wine are changed into the Body and Blood of Christ.

We believe that Jesus Christ is present, body and soul, humanity and divinity, in the Holy Eucharist.



The doctrine that the Body and Blood of Christ are each present in both the Blessed Sacrament and the Precious Blood (the theological term is "concomitance") means that if the faithful receive the consecrated host alone or drink

from the chalice alone, they have received both the Body and Blood of Christ.

For many centuries, the Catholic faithful received the Body and Blood of Christ while only receiving the consecrated host at Mass. Since about 1970, more Catholic parishes began offering Holy Communion under both "species"; with the faithful having the option of receiving both the host and drinking the Precious Blood from the chalice.

On the weekend of June 22/23, the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, St. Raphael will offer Holy Communion under both species at several of the liturgies. Please listen for the instructions about the distribution of Holy Communion before each Mass.
