CATECHISM CORNER



The Coronation of Mary is one form of reverence frequently shown to images of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This is an ancient practice of the Christian churches in both the East and in the West. The crowning of an image of the Blessed Virgin Mary, especially in the West, became widespread for the faithful.

The queen symbol was attributed to Mary because she is a perfect follower of Christ, who is the absolute 'crown' of creation. As the Order of Crowning states: She is the Mother of the Son of God, who is the messianic King. Mary is

the Mother of Christ, the Word incarnate. The maid of Nazareth consented to God's plan; she journeyed on the pilgrimage of faith; she listened to God's word and kept it in her heart; she remained steadfastly in close union with her Son, all the way to the foot of the cross; she persevered in prayer with the Church. Thus, in an eminent way she won the "crown of righteousness" that is promised to those who follow Christ.

In the United States, a custom developed that grew in popularity prior to the Vatican II council. In parishes, at Marian shrines, and at grottos, someone was chosen to place a wreath of flowers on Mary's image. The practice continues in many parishes today. Many of them have found innovative ways to express their reverence for the dignity of Mary, the Mother of God and of our Lord Jesus Christ.
