SAINT KATHARINE DREXEL FEAST DAY NOVENA



Saint Katharine Drexel founded the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament, dedicated to sharing the message of the Gospel and the life of the Eucharist. The feast day for Saint Katharine Drexel is March 3rd and so we will honor her with a nine-day novena beginning February 23rd. The novena prayers will be said after each weekday Mass through March 3rd. Saint Katharine died on March 3, 1955 and was canonized on October 1, 2000.

THE EXAMEN: The Examen is a method of reviewing your day in the presence of God. It's actually an attitude more than a method, a time set aside for thankful reflection on where God is in your everyday life. It has five steps, which most people take more or less in order, and it usually takes 15 to 20 minutes per day:

1. **ASK GOD FOR LIGHT:** I want to look at my day with God's eyes, not merely my own.
2. **GIVE THANKS:** The day I have just lived is a gift from God. Be grateful for it.
3. **REVIEW THE DAY:** I look back on the day just completed, being guided by the Holy Spirit.
4. **FACE YOUR SHORTCOMINGS:** I face up to what is wrong – in my life and in me.
5. **LOOK TOWARD THE DAY TO COME:** I ask where I need God in the day to come.
