- 1. Fast from hurting words and say kind words.

- 3. Fast from anger and be filled with patience.
- 4. Fast from pessimism and be filled with hope.
- 5. Fast from worries and trust in God.
- 6. Fast from complaints and contemplate simplicity.
- 7. Fast from pressures and be prayerful.
- 8. Fast from bitterness and fill your heart with joy.
- 9. Fast from selfishness and *be compassionate to others*.
- 10. Fast from grudges and be reconciled.
- 11. Fast from words and be silent so you can listen.

SAINT KATHARINE DREXEL FEAST DAY NOVENA



Saint Katharine Drexel founded the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament, dedicated to sharing the message of the Gospel and the life of the Eucharist. The feast day for Saint Katharine Drexel is March 3rd and so we will honor her with a nine-day novena beginning February 22nd. The novena prayers will be said after each weekday Mass through March 3rd. Saint Katharine died on March 3, 1955 and was canonized on October 1, 2000.
