January 17, 2021

1. A disciple of Jesus follows him and shares the Good News with others.
2. Eli finally realizes that God was calling Samuel.
3. When Andrew asks Jesus where he lives, Jesus says, "Come and see."
4. Jesus calls each of us to be his friend and follow him. He calls each of us to be his disciple.
5. We learn about God's love and Jesus' teachings when we listen to the reading and homily at Mass.

January 24, 2021

1. Simon and Andrew left behind their nets and their jobs as fishermen to follow Jesus.
2. The name of the sea where Jesus' first followers were fishermen was the Sea of Galilee.
3. Every follower of Jesus has a vocation to live a life of love and holiness, serving God and his people.
4. A missionary is called by God and sent to bring the Good News to others.
5. Accept all reasonable answers for those who "catch" people for Jesus at a parish, including priests, deacons, sisters, and others.

January 31, 2021

1. Accept reasonable answers, such as forgiving, loving, peacemaking, caring, trusting, sharing, singing, working, and playing.
2. Jesus commands the bad spirit to leave the man and it does.
3. Jesus performed miracles so that people believed and as a sign of God's power.
4. The Gospel story shows that Jesus has the power to teach and heal when he tells the unclean spirit to leave a man, and it does.
5. We say that we believe Jesus is God's Son when we pray the Creed.

February 7, 2021

1. The Seven Sacraments give us God's grace.
2. Everyone could see that Saint Martin was a holy man because he spent hours praying to God and worked long hours for the poor and sick.
3. Jesus says that he has come to visit towns and preach there.
4. Jesus gave the Seven Sacraments to the Church.
5. The sacraments use signs that we can see, hear, smell, taste, and touch. They make Jesus' loving, healing, and forgiving real in our lives.

February 14, 2021

1. People were afraid of leprosy because it gave people sores on their bodies and faces. They lost fingers, toes, and noses and later died.
2. Father Damien wanted the people sick with leprosy to know that God loved them.
3. Jesus tells the man with leprosy that he wants him to get better. He then says: “Be well!”
4. During Lent, we are asked by the Church to pray, sacrifice, and help others.
5. During Lent, we can pray for people we don’t like and those who are different or left out.

February 21, 2021

1. A rainbow was the sign of a Covenant between God and all living things. God said he would never again flood all the earth.
2. Mark wanted his scared friends to remember that God had raised Jesus to new life and would help them too.
3. A covenant is a commitment of faith and love between God and his people.
4. The Devil couldn’t tempt Jesus because Jesus trusted his Father’s promises.
5. God promises to be with us, protect us, strengthen us, forgive us, love us, and to share life in Heaven with us.

February 28, 2021

1. Accept reasonable answers, such as Jesus is a Healer, the Son of God, and a Teacher.
2. In the Gospel reading, Jesus’ clothes became dazzling white.
3. The voice from the cloud said: “This is my beloved Son. Listen to him.”
4. The Transfiguration gives us an idea about what Jesus will look like in Heaven.
5. The Transfiguration gives us a peek at our future with God. If we do God’s will and follow Jesus, God promises that we will go to Heaven. Our bodies will shine with God’s glory in Heaven.

March 7, 2021

1. For Jewish people, the Temple is the house of God.
2. Jesus’ followers did not understand what he meant until he had been raised from the dead.
3. The Third Commandment says to keep the Lord’s Day holy, meaning we go to Mass on Sunday.
4. The Fifth Commandment is you shall not kill, which means we respect and protect all life.
5. Being holy means that a person puts God first by showing love to God and others.
