February 14, 2021

3. Respect means to show that a person or thing has been created by God. It means caring for it and treating it well.
4. Jesus cares for the sick, for those who are left out, and for you and me.
5. Accept reasonable answers, such as praying, sharing, and caring for others.

February 21, 2021
