## January 17, 2021

1. The pope is the bishop of Rome, the leader of the worldwide Roman Catholic Church, and the successor to Saint Peter.
2. Andrew leaves Jesus to go find his brother, Peter, and to tell him they have found the Messiah.
3. Jesus changes Simon's name to Peter calling him to be a strong and steady follower, like a rock.
4. A vocation is a job or state of life to which God calls each of us. It is saying yes to God.
5. No matter what we are called to do, we all have the same mission, which is to bring people to know and love God.

## January 24, 2021

1. The four Gospels are Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John, and the word gospel means "good news."
2. Sacred Tradition is the Gospel message that has been handed down through the preaching of the Apostles of the Church of the present day.
3. Jesus tells Andrew and Simon to come with him, and he will teach them how to catch people.
4. The Church is a community because it is made up of people who journey, talk, eat, and learn together.
5. Capernaum is important because when Jesus starts his public ministry, he makes the city his headquarters.

## January 31, 2021

1. Life was hard for Father Tolton because many people did not think a Black man should be a priest.
2. A synagogue is the name for the place Jewish people gather for prayer and instruction under the guidance of a teacher called a rabbi.
3. Jesus told the unclean spirit to leave the man and it did.
4. Jesus teaches that no one who seeks God will be outside of his love, and he reveals that he has the power to heal and teach in God's own name.
5. Accept any reasonable answer for how one share God's love with those who need it most.

## February 7, 2021

1. After Jesus heals here, Simon's mother-in-law begins to serve his new community.
2. The word compassion means "to feel with, such as feeling sad when others are sad or joy when others are happy.
3. Accept any reasonable answers, such as sharing compassion can help people cope with suffering.
4. The Church continues Jesus' healing work in the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.
5. A disciple is someone who responds to Jesus' call to follow and who helps spread Jesus' message through loving service of others.

## February 14, 2021

1. The man with leprosy showed his faith by telling Jesus that if he wanted to, Jesus could heal him and make him clean.
2. So many people wanted to see Jesus that he could not enter a town openly, so he stayed in deserted places.
3. Jesus is a teacher in everything he does because we always learn something, such as how to treat others, how to accept hardships and pain, and how to love.
4. When we take part in Holy Communion, we nourish our commitment to live and love as Jesus did.
5. A homily explains the meaning of the liturgy's Scripture readings, especially the Gospel.

## February 21, 2021

1. Jesus stays in the desert for forty days while Satan tests him.
2. A covenant is an agreement between two human beings and between God and human beings.
3. Among satisfactory answers are: The forty days of Lent invite to put ourselves to the test and recognize the ways we want to grow as Christians. It allows us to find ways we need to turn to God. We can break habits and turn toward others in loving ways.
4. Accept any reasonable answers, such as Jesus resists Satan's temptations, he remembers that he is God's servant, and he obeys what God wants.
5. God's covenant with Noah is that he will never again destroy the earth.

## February 28, 2021

1. Jesus' disciples saw him transfigured. They also saw Elijah and Moses talking to Jesus, and a voice from a cloud tells them that this is my beloved Son; listen to him.
2. The Gospel of the Transfiguration reminds us that even though Jesus will suffer and die on the Cross, he will rise in glory and win for us a new life in Heaven.
3. Jesus' love was stronger than death and broke its power.
4. God promised Abraham and Sarah that their children, those who believe in God, would become as many as the stars of the night.
5. The first three commandments tell us how to worship God. The other seven tell us how to respect and honor one another.

## March 7, 2021

1. The People of God promised to keep all of the Ten Commandments in order to make a covenant with him.
2. Jesus became angry with the merchants because they had made his Father's house into a marketplace.
3. Jesus was referring to his body, but the disciples did not understand his words until his Resurrection.
4. To keep God's commandments and Jesus' teaching, we honor God in all that we do and say, we attend Mass on Sunday, we respect ourselves and others, and we are kind to others and give to those in need.
5. A mortal sin is a very serious sin that is deliberate and completely separates us from God. A venial sin is harmful, but it does not destroy our relationship with God.
