Please note the following:

- ❖ * Tentative - March 16, May 26 and May 27 - Possible School Days if we have to give back any snow days for school closings.

- ❖ If student **will not** be present the last day of school, **NO REPORT CARDS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED BEFORE JUNE 19TH**.
Parents MUST send in a self-addressed STAMPED envelope to their child's homeroom teacher (separate envelopes if more than one child). It will be mailed to your home after dismissal on June 19th.
The Teachers **WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE to pick up at school on a later date.**
NO REPORT CARDS are left in the school office.

- ❖ All Dress Down money **MUST** be sent with **exact amount of \$2.00. No change will be given.** No checks accepted only cash for Dress Down.
Each student must have \$2.00 in an envelope with their name and class clearly marked on the outside along with DRESS DOWN MONEY and given to their homeroom teacher. **Siblings in different classes CANNOT be combined in one envelope. Each student submits their own Dress Down Money (exactly \$2.00 in cash) as Homeroom teachers' record payments for their own class.**

- ❖ Please note above the dismissal times for Faculty Meetings on the First Friday of the month.

- ❖ Homeroom teachers will arrange scheduling for report card pick-up when mandatory. NO report cards will be given to children when it is mandatory for a parent to meet with the teacher.
NO report Cards are distributed if any financial obligations are not met which include, tuition, after-school, lunch/breakfast or fundraising fees.

- ❖ When sending in any money for FUNDRAISING, it **MUST** be **Check or Money Order.** We **WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY CHECKS FROM ANYONE THAT DOES NOT HAVE A STUDENT IN OUR SCHOOL.** If someone is purchasing Candles, Pies or Chocolate from you, **YOU MUST** submit payment with your check. Please NO INTERNET orders with Yankee Candle as we cannot monitor your sales and deduct from fundraising obligation. **If your last name is different from your child, please note on the check in memo student's name and class.**

- ❖ When sending any cash to school for class trips, notebooks, After-School to the office **EXACT CHANGE MUST BE SENT.** We never ask for money one day ahead. There is ample enough time to have exactly the amount owed sent it. If your payment requires change, it will be returned until exact amount is sent it.

- ❖ Do not forget to include your child's name and class on anything sent to the office.
