

Dear Second Grade Families,

Allow me to introduce myself. My name is Stephanie Gucits. I will be your child's Second Grade Teacher.

I am looking forward to working with you and your child this upcoming school year. Attached you will find the 2nd Grade Supply List.

All school supplies will be due by the first week of school.

Please make sure to label *ALL* of your child's supplies with their names and grade.

*****All supplies must be placed in a small clear 8 x 5 inches and 2 inches deep container labeled with the child's name and grade. *(Supplies will be kept at school)***

*****Children should have a set of supplies at home to complete their homework.**

*****Children should have their own small hand sanitizer and a small pack of tissues in their clear container daily for their own personal use.**

- 10 No. 2 sharpened pencils for the week
- Canvas pencil case with zipper only
- 2 Pencil sharpeners (manual with a top to collect shavings) -One to keep at home
- 2 Large pink erasers (One for home)
- 2 Yellow Highlighters (One for Home)
- 2 Crayola 24 ct of crayons *(One to keep at home for HW)*
- *-Place 1 pack of crayons in a small clear ziploc bag labeled for school)*
- 2 Crayola sets of markers *(One to keep at home)*
- 2 Rulers with English and metric measurements (One for Home)
- 5 large glue sticks *(Two to keep at home for HW)*
- 2 Child appropriate aged scissors (One to keep at home)
- 6 two pocket durable folders labeled with the child's name (red, yellow, blue, green, orange, black) *The blue folder will be your child's homework folder. With a Black Sharpie, Label the left side "Keep at Home" and the right side "Return to School" to help your child organize his/her papers.*
- 10 Composition Notebooks (Reading, Phonics/Spelling, Math, Science/Social Studies, Writing, Homework, Spanish, Religion) Children can begin to bring their notebooks on the first day of school. However, only bring in 2 a day until all notebooks are brought into school. I do not want their backpacks to be too heavy for them.
- Please bring in your seat sack from First Grade if you still have it

During the Second Week of School Please Bring in:

2 Roll of Paper Towels

2 Box of Tissues

1 large bottle of Hand Sanitizer

1 pack of Clorox/Lysol Wipes.
